Conference Overview

COVID-19 has most certainly affected medical care practice. Re-envisioning Elder Care will focus on updates in geriatric medical practice, including changes in the continuum of care based on the COVID-19 experience. We will discuss impacts of COVID-19 diagnosis and recovery in long-term care, current knowledge of post-COVID illness, challenges in telehealth implementation in older adult patients, and the importance of advance care planning to help families plan for health emergencies.

Dr. Gillespie is Associate Professor of Medicine in the Division of Geriatrics/Aging and Associate Professor of Emergency Medicine at the University of Rochester School of Medicine and Dentistry. She is a two-time recipient of the competitive Geriatric Academic Career Award from the Department of Health and Human Resources for her work in geriatric education related to quality improvement in long term care. Her research focuses on quality of care nursing home and home-based care settings. She is currently the President-Elect of AMDA The Society for Post-Acute Long-Term Care.
